Shifty Slides

*Check "A" 4s on A-string with Harmonic.



IN ALL SHIFTS, WATCH THE FINGER'S "FACE"/fingernail—it is to be kept the same in angle to string.

- 1. Left arm pendulum action is used to balance/roll fingers away from the open string when played with shift.
- 2. Shifts/slides are to be well heard for coordination and intonation of the left arm, hand, fingers and thumb.
- 3. Memorize the measurement/touch of the slide's distance matched by the pitch change.



Vibrato

Play the pitch (pt) then pivot/roll fingertip below pitch by moving the arm and hand away from the violin, then return to start again—always begin and end with note's pitch in tune.
